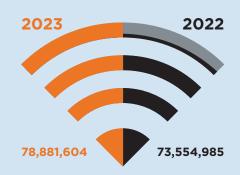

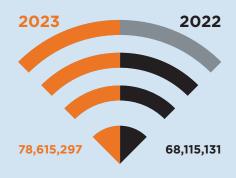

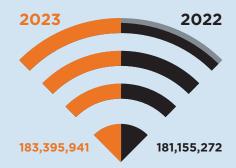
OPERATING REVENUE

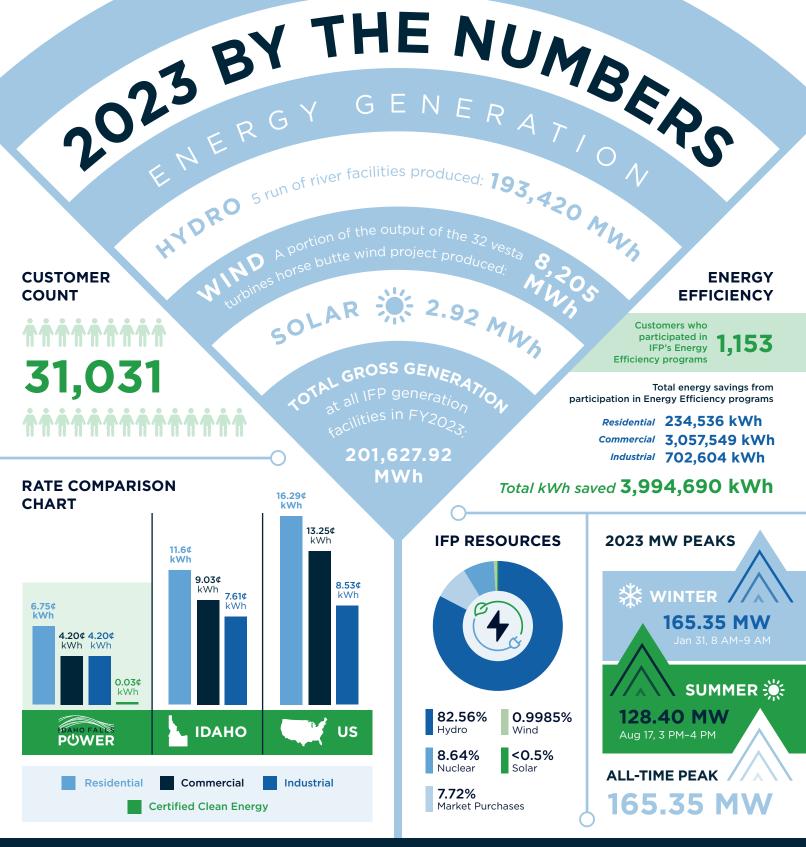


OPERATING EXPENSES
